



## Board Meeting March 25, 2009

Meeting called to order at 6:05 pm. Minutes from last Board meeting of September 17th were read. Motion was made to accept the meeting minutes of February 18; the motion was seconded and accepted.

Kathy Wainhouse: Skating Directors Report: Awards Banquet May 9<sup>th</sup> at Fircrest Golf Club. Sign up on bulletin board. Need RSVP by April 17<sup>th</sup>. Cost \$27.00 per person. There are 75 medals to be given out: unsure of the number of skaters receiving medal. Will get with Sonja for information.

Summer school programs: will have brochure out and available by Annual Meeting.

Kathy Casey Seminar: Registration Fees \$75 for LWC Skater. Special 1 hours session for Adult skaters at \$20 per skater. Cost for non LWC members \$150.00
